EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15 I will rain down bread from Heaven for you.
Psalm 78 "The Lord gave them bread from Heaven."
Ephesians 4:17, 20-24 Put on the new self that has been created in God's way.
John 6:24-35 Whoever comes to Me will never hunger, and whoever believes in Me will never thirst.

Asked about Moses and the manna in the desert, Jesus tells the crowd that the Bread of God gives life to the world. Then He goes on to say that He Himself is the Bread of Life. Accustomed as we are to hearing this phrase, especially in Communion songs, it is a phrase worth meditating on. As we hear God's holy word proclaimed today, let us listen for clues about what it means for Jesus to be the Bread of Life.
